

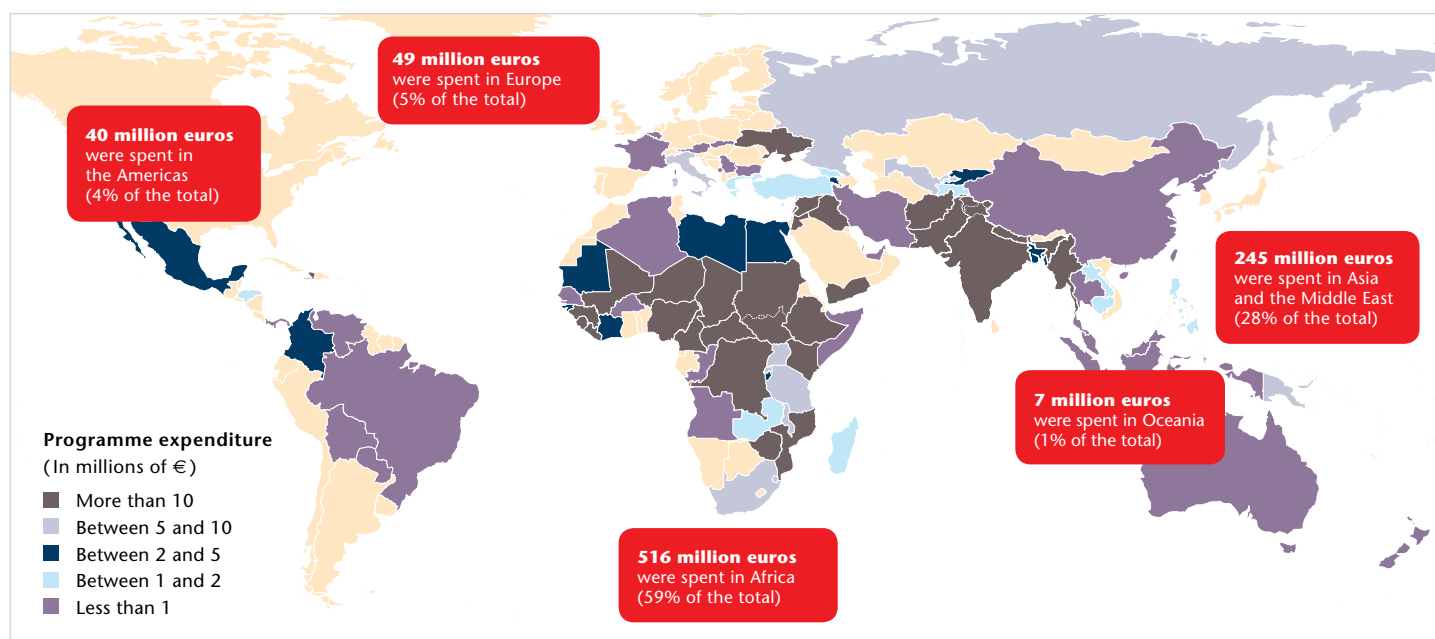
MÉDECINS SANS FRONTIÈRES FINANCIAL REPORT 2015

Total expenditure in 2015 was 1,283 million euros, an increase of 217 million euros over 2014. This expenditure can be broken down into two main categories: social mission and other expenses. MSF's social mission accounted for 82% of total expenditure in 2015.

In October 2015, the Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) Kunduz trauma centre in Afghanistan was targeted by US airstrikes, which resulted in the deaths of 14 staff, 24 patients and four patient caretakers. Over one million people in northeastern Afghanistan remain deprived of high-quality surgical care as a result. In 2015 alone, 106 aerial bombing and shelling attacks hit 75 MSF hospitals and MSF-supported hospitals in Syria, Yemen, Ukraine, Afghanistan and Sudan.

From Syria, Lebanon and Jordan, to the Lake Chad region of western Africa and along the migrant route to and through Europe, MSF provided humanitarian assistance and lifesaving medical care to people forced to flee their homes and countries this year as a result of conflict and violence. In response to the EU's failure to put in place effective and humane policies and responses to deal with the unprecedented movement of people, MSF also conducted search and rescue operations to save the lives of refugees and migrants at risk of drowning on the Mediterranean and Aegean seas.

In 2015, 7,800 health professionals, logistics specialists and administrative staff of all nationalities left on field assignments to join over 31,000 locally hired staff working in medical programmes in 69 countries.

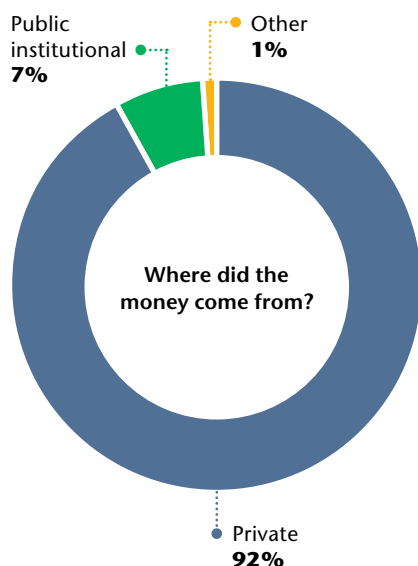

2015 saw an increase in income for MSF compared with 2014. Total incoming resources of 1.44 billion euros for 2015 were 163 million euros more than in 2014. 2015's higher income was due mainly to the increased private income received.

More than 5.7 million individual donors and private funders provided 92% of MSF's private income in 2015.

After adjusting for exchange gains and losses, MSF shows a surplus of 167 million euros. MSF has a reserves policy, at an international level, of holding a minimum of three months and a maximum of 12 months of total expenditure as retained earnings. The level of reserves at 31 December 2015 equates to approximately 9.8 months of the year's activity.
